Father of Nuclear Medicine in Egypt

- Born 23 April 1928 and graduated from Kasr El-Aini Medical School in 1950 with a grade of very good and received his Doctorate in Internal Medicine in 1957.
- ▼ A professor of Internal Medicine in 1972, and Chairman of the department of Internal Medicine from 1983 to 1988. In 1985 he was also appointed head of the National Committee for promotion to Professorship in Internal Medicine.
- He spent 2 years as a fellow in Nuclear Medicine at Johns Hopkins University, Baltimore, Maryland, USA from 1960 to 1961. Also went as an associate professor to Case Western Reserve University in USA from 1966 to 1968. During this time, he was also a lecturer of Nuclear Medicine at the Nuclear Medicine Institute in Cleveland.
- ▼ From 1976 to 1977, he was a visiting professor at the University of Iowa, in Iowa City, Iowa, USA
- As an added mark of his international standing, he became an International Expert for the International Atomic Energy Agency in Vienna in 1972. He was sent on a 3 month teaching and training mission to Albania in 1972, and in Pakistan in 1992.
- In addition to numerous presentations in the international nuclear medicine conferences and a large number of papers published in the international peer reviewed journals of nuclear medicine.
- ♥ He is also co-editor of the "Textbook of Nuclear Medicine Technology" published in 1969, and with two new editions in 1975 and 1979
- ◆ He established the nuclear medicine departments in Maadi Military Hospital in the 70's, and Arab Contractors Medical Center in the 80's.

- ◆ He established Egyptian Society of nuclear medicine specialists and he was the president 1997 till he died 4 July 2011.
